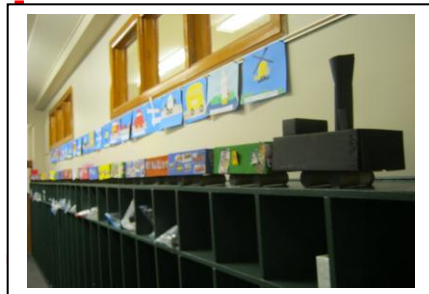
Scientific Wednesday
