Our Christmas Tree

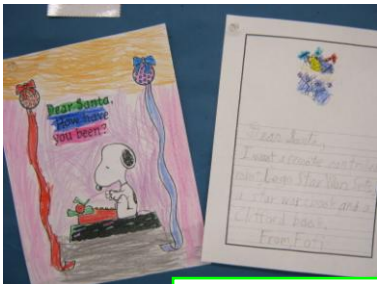

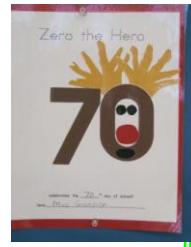


Scientists demonstrated for classmates this week's experiment by exploring color, saturation, and absorption with coffee filters and markers.
