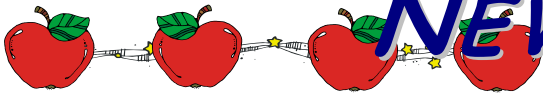

### Bridget the Alligator

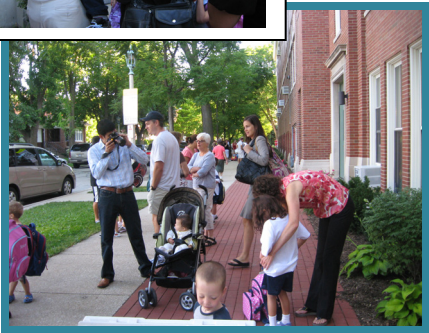

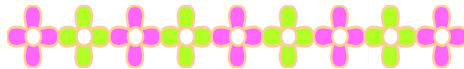
