The scoop on ticket orders, lunch forms, and raffle sheets:

1. "**Mission Day Package**": All students, grade 1 to 8, will purchase the "Mission Day Package" that will include a movie, popcorn, and lunch and drink for \$5. Pre-orders for early education is encouraged, please mark the WILL CALL box on your order form.
2. Cookies, cupcakes, Rice Krispies treats, and brownies can be purchased for dessert at the pastry booth.
3. Families may pay for all their children's Master Order Forms with one check, but each child must have his or her own order form.
4. **Raffle money must be kept separate from ticket and package orders.** Raffle money may be sent in individually (by student) or as a family. Please send in Raffle money with the filled-in raffle sheets in a separate envelope labeled "Raffle."
