GOLDFISH SURVIVAL SKILLS:

Many families have shared their tips for keeping the Mission Day goldfish alive and happy.

1. Have the fish bowl ready with the treated water ahead of time.
2. Place the water-filled bag with the goldfish still in it in the bowl for an hour or so to allow the temperature of the water in the bag and the bowl to equalize.
3. Change the water regularly and use filtered water if possible. Use those little drops that are supposed to make the water safer for the little fishes.
4. Don't overfeed. One goldfish requires one food flake every other day.

REMEMBER TO BRING A BAG FOR ALL YOUR GOODIES, AND THAT IT IS AN OUT-OF-UNIFORM DAY.
