

School Appearance on Casual Out of Uniform Days and Casual Out of Uniform Field Trips

Looks like

- Slacks, trousers, jeans, capri's, knee-length shorts, knee-length skirts are all worn at the waist.
- Shirts/blouses have sleeves and crew-type necklines; all clothing is modest
- All clothing is neat, clean and in good repair and appropriately sized.
- Shoes have closed-toe, closed heel, are fastened, and socks are worn.
- Clean faces
- Clear lip balm (optional)
- Clean-shaven faces for boys
- Neatly combed hair
- Small earrings for girls only (optional)
- Appropriate jewelry (optional)

Does not look like

- Pajama bottoms, skirts rolled up, pants worn too high or too low; shorts or skirts that are too short.
- Any clothing that is too tight or revealing.
- Sleeveless clothing, (halter-tops, tank tops, spaghetti straps), bare midriffs.
- Torn, soiled, outgrown or oversized clothing.
- Sandals, flip-flops, clogs, or any back-less footwear; outdoor boots, backs of shoes turned under, shoes not fastened, or shoes worn without socks. Defaced or painted shoes.
- Make-up, glitter, stickers, mascara, eye shadow, lipstick, tinted lip-gloss
- Tattoos, drawing on hands, arms or legs
- Mustaches, beards, long sideburns
- Bandanas, extreme hairstyles, hair falling into eyes, hair touching shirt collar on boys, partially shaved heads, or hats worn indoors
- Excessive or inappropriate jewelry

School Appearance on Dress-up Out of Uniform Days and Dress-up Out of Uniform Field Trips

Looks like

- Dress slacks, trousers, dresses, knee-length skirts all worn at the waist.
- Shirts with collars for boys; girls' shirts/blouses have sleeves and modest necklines
- All clothing neat, clean and in good repair and appropriately sized.
- Shoes are fastened and have closed heel or back-strap.
- Clean faces
- Clear lip balm (optional)
- Clean-shaven faces for boys
- Neatly combed hair
- Small earrings for girls only (optional)
- Appropriate jewelry (optional)

Does not look like

- Jeans, shorts, skirts rolled up; pants too high or too low; skirts that are too short.
- Any clothing that is too tight or revealing.
- Sleeveless clothing, (halter-tops, tank tops, spaghetti straps), bare midriffs and any shirts with slogans or pictures
- Torn, soiled, outgrown or oversized clothing
- Sandals, flip-flops, clogs, or any back-less footwear; outdoor boots, back of shoe turned under, shoes not fastened. Defaced or painted shoes.
- Make-up, glitter, stickers, mascara, eye shadow, lipstick, tinted lip-gloss
- Tattoos, drawing on hands, arms or legs
- Mustaches, beards, long sideburns
- Bandanas, extreme hairstyles, hair falling into eyes, hair touching shirt collar on boys, partially shaved heads or hats worn indoors.
- Excessive or inappropriate jewelry
